GRADUATE SUPPORT PROGRAM

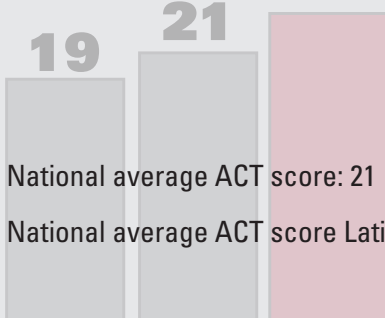
- The ultimate goal is for Nativity students to graduate from college

of Nativity graduates are accepted into college.

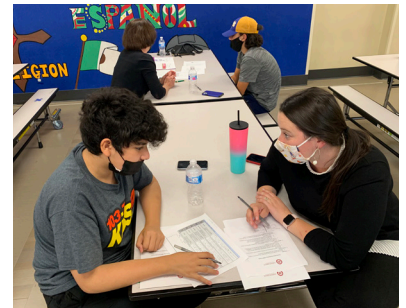

- Connect with student via phone, text or email every two weeks
- Attend monthly meetings and quarterly social events at Nativity
